Overview of the Workshop:

The New Education Policy (NEP) 2020 states that quality enhancement and sustaining is the need of the hour; this enhances the role of NAAC and other regulatory agencies tremendously. NAAC Accreditation frame work is one of the methods widely used for performance assessment of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to transform themselves as knowledge hubs. NAAC has been set up to facilitate the volunteering institutions to assess their performance vis-a-vis set parameters through introspection and a process that provides space for participation of the institution. NAAC accreditation helps the HEIs to analyse their strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and challenges through an informed review process. Beside this, the NAAC accreditation will help funding agencies with objective data so that they can take a decision on the funding of HEIs. NAAC grade/assessment may also help educational institutes to initiate modern or innovative methods of pedagogy. On the other hand, NAAC accreditation or grade of a HEIs will help the student to figure out all the details about the institute such as quality of education, research output, teaching-learning, infrastructure etc. NAAC grade helps students to choose the best institute based on its NAAC grade/ performance in the NAAC accreditation process. This workshop has been planned to motivate faculties of the College to initiate and share the best practices as well as to undergo the evaluation of the same with the assessment and accreditation by NAAC.

Objective of the Workshop:

This workshop is intended to induct the stakeholders about standard operating procedures and the compilation of data as per the revised template and manual of NAAC. It focuses on the issues related to the preparation of Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) and Self-Study Report (SSR) according to the prescribed key indicators and quantitative and qualitative metrics in various criteria.
